【<概要>又は<一般目標 : G I O>】  
 This course is designed primarily to promote students' English speaking ability by providing opportunities to interact in activities involving all four language skills, but especially listening and speaking. Students will participate in individual, pair and group exercises to emphasize and practise the main grammatical, vocabulary, pronunciation and function points of each unit.
